    - 606 to employees and spouses




### **QUALITY INITIATIVES**




New State-of-the-Art Covid testing equipment is purchased in 2021 to provide better service to our community.

- A new medication dispensing system (Pyxis) is purchased to enhance nursing care.
- Software agreement is signed to upgrade the outpatient employee prescription program.
- Software is upgraded on 100+ IV pumps.

#### School of Nursing

- Updated Simulation equipment for Pediatric, Adult, and Obstetrics instructions.
- Moved to Canvas Learning Management System and Studio to enhance remote education quality.
- Purchased Shadow Health for virtual simulation opportunities to give Students additional experience working with specific health conditions.
- Invested in enhanced ATI to better prepare nursing students for Board Exams.

## **Hospital Exterior**

 The 1925, 1959, 1968, 1977 and 1983 Graham Hospital Campus Buildings receive new windows and new exteriors, sealing the building envelope.

### **Patient Gare**

- Addition of permanent airborne isolation rooms in the Emergency Department and in three of our inpatient units:
  - Medical Surgical
  - PCU
  - ICU
- Construction began creating four additional beds to our growing Intensive Care Unit.
- Emergency Department installs new floors to help with noise reduction.

- Added Pressure Motive condensate return systems to minimize heat loss
- New 400-ton Chiller installed, adding cooling capacity and redundancy
- Completed Piping Project in our 1968 and 1977 buildings
- Added Air Handler controls on multiple air handlers at GH
- Added New Humidification system in the Surgery Suites

#### Website

 A new Graham Health System website is built allowing us to be more agile and responsive to our patients and community.

#### • Electronic Health Record (EHR)

- Our Hospital EHR software, Meditech, is upgraded allowing more functionality.
- External software is sunset due to enhanced functionality of updated software.
  - Laboratory converts our auto-verification process to the new Meditech platform.
  - Pharmacy moves to convert our Antimicrobial Stewardship Program to Meditech.

#### Telephone

• New redundant, more reliable phone infrastructure is installed.

#### Image Sharing platform

 Change Healthcare software is purchased and implemented to improve viewing of our patients' previous medical images for comparison to new images.

#### Videoconferencing

• Teams and Teams Rooms are installed allowing for better communication and collaboration.
